## **BREWER'S TABLE**

### **Austin, Texas**

Craft beer and food share the spotlight in East Austin's Govalle neighborhood. Seasonal in-house brews infused with ingredients from local farms sit alongside a selection of rotating guest taps. Dishes like venison tartare with toasted brewer's yeast and aged pork ribs with black beer vinegar connect the menu and brews beyond pairing suggestions.

## **WALDEN**

### **Nashville, Tennessee**

Named for the Henry David Thoreau work, Nashville's Walden boasts a neighborhood dive bar feel with exposed wooden beams, bench swings, and a dog-friendly outdoor patio. Beer, wine, and cocktails—including negronis, old fashioned, and moscow mules—are all available on tap.

## **GRAFT WINE SHOP**

### **Charleston, South Carolina**

In a city abuzz with wine-centric openings, it's tough to stand out from the crowd. Downtown newcomer Graft is making its mark with pop-up dinners (keep an eye on their Instagram feed) and a low-key shop-and-sip vibe. The shelves are stocked with some 200 options geared toward Charleston's adventurous wine-drinking crowd.

## **THE YELLOW CUP**

### **Houston, Texas**

Named for yellow traffic lights—when drivers are present and aware of their surroundings as they make a split-second decision—Houston's the Yellow Cup coffee and tea shop sources beans and leaves directly from growers around the world and pastries are supplied from a local Swiss bakery.
